

RENEGADE RACEWAY RETURN TO RACING

Health and Safety Protocols revised June 2020

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Racers and crew members only. No spectators allowed at this time.
- Masks required.
- Racers/crew are strongly encouraged to bring own PPE (masks, gloves, sanitizer).
- Racers/crew will be required to remain in their respective pit areas when not at tech, in staging lanes, or picking up concessions.
- Track crew limited to essential positions only.
- Track crew will provide frequent sanitation of common touchpoint areas.
- Social distancing to be maintained.
- Those who are ill or have pre-existing conditions are encouraged to remain home.
- Pit parking – racers will be parked within guidelines of appropriate social distancing at track manager's discretion.
- Timing tower will be off-limits to all but essential track personnel. Racers needing assistance should seek out a crew member on the ground to relay their message to tower or track operator.
- One car length distance to be maintained in the tech lane. Racers may be advised to remain in vehicle or step away from their vehicle while inspection is completed, at tech director's discretion.
- One car length distance to be maintained in staging lanes. Racers are to remain in vehicle while in staging and crew members must stay with their car and driver.
- Classes will be called to staging lanes as needed via FM 88.1
- Starting line will be restricted to racers, essential track personnel and essential race crew. Crew members should vacate the starting line area as quickly as possible.
- Soap and hand sanitizer will be available in restrooms and racers/crew are encouraged to bring their own as well.
- Golf carts guidelines: Racers/crew will be asked to limit golf cart usage to those in their family/crew only. Operators of pit vehicles must be 16 or older.
- Social distancing will be maintained in staging lanes and along fence line.
